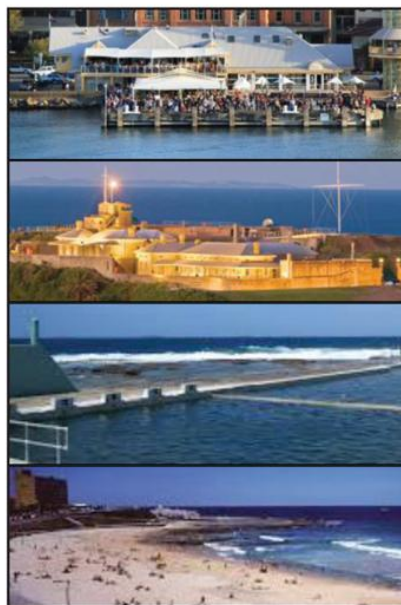


# HOP ON / HOP OFF SHUTTLE BUS Runs All Day : 9am-3pm

## THINGS TO DO : *Optional Activities at Each Stop*



### Fort Scratchley

- View the fort precinct, which is the only Australian fort to have fired on the enemy.
- Fabulous photo opportunities exist with 360 degree panoramic views of the ocean, coastline, lighthouse, harbour, and city.
- A guided tour of the Fort brings the fascinating history of this national treasure to life.
- Also tour the amazing network of underground tunnels at Fort Scratchley.



### Sheppards Hill Lookout

- View the WWII Sheppards Hill Observation Post, and the historic Sheppards Hill Cottage.
- Great photo opportunities from the sunny, grassed area with commanding views overlooking the Newcastle CBD, Newcastle Beach, and the sweeping sand dunes to Port Stephens.
- A pathway leads down the hill (north) through King Edward Park to The Bogey Hole, an 18th century hand built ocean rock pool which is popular with local swimmers. ( approx 650m walk )
- For the energetic, there is a 2.5km walk (south) along Bathers Way, past Strzlecki Lookout, along the Bar Beach / Dixon Park / Merewether Beach strip, arriving at Merewether Surfhouse.



### Merewether Surfhouse

- This venue overlooks one of Australia's most famous surfing locations. It is a National Surfing Reserve, the venue of the international Surfquest competition, and the location of the largest ocean baths in the Southern Hemisphere. Feel free to have a swim !!! - The venue is ideal for a coffee or morning tea. Or, sit back, relax, and enjoy an alcoholic beverage, soft drink, snack or lunch at this scenic licensed premises, and then hop back on the shuttle bus later in the day, for the journey back to Queens Wharf at Newcastle Harbour.



### Queens Wharf Brewery

- At this location you can experience the unique scenery of coal ships and freight ships sharing the harbour with cruise liners, fishing boats, ferries, and private vessels.
